Drugo izdanje Silver Frame Film Festivala od 14. do 17. jula 2025. u Srebrenici i Bratuncu

Srebrenica / Bratunac, juli 2025. — Drugo izdanje **Silver Frame Film Festivala** održat će se od **14. do 17. jula 2025. godine** u **Srebrenici i Bratuncu**, donoseći četiri dana filmskih projekcija, razgovora, masterklasova, radionica, izložbi i filmske rezidencije.

Festival okuplja filmove i autore iz različitih dijelova svijeta, ali istovremeno ostaje snažno povezan s lokalnom zajednicom. Program će se odvijati na više lokacija, uključujući **Open Air Cinema i Cinema Room u EMMAUS-u, Dom kulture Srebrenica i Dom kulture Bratunac.**

Ulaz na festivalske programe je besplatan.

Ovogodišnje izdanje donosi **sedam dugometražnih filmova**, kao i **37 kratkometražnih filmova iz cijelog svijeta** u takmičarskim programima.

Festival će svečano otvoriti animirani film **Flow**, reditelja **Gintsa Zilbalodisa**, dobitnik nagrade Oscar.

U programu dugometražnih filmova bit će prikazani i **Gym** Srđana Vuletića, u saradnji sa **Sarajevo Film Festivalom**; **Vermiglio** Maure Delpero, u saradnji sa **Trieste Film Festivalom**; **Where Dragons Live** Suzanne Raes, u saradnji sa berlinskim festivalom **Dokumentale**; **An American Pastoral** Auberi Edler, zahvaljujući saradnji sa **Mediawan Rights**; te **Vittoria** Alessandra Cassigolija i Caseyja Kauffmana, u partnerstvu sa **MedFilm Festivalom** iz Rima.

Festival će predstaviti više takmičarskih programa kratkog filma: **International Short Films, Green Short Films, Regional Student Short Films, International Student Short Films i Silver Frame Spotlight.**

Međunarodni program kratkog filma nastavlja se razvijati uz podršku počasnih selektora povezanih s nekim od najznačajnijih međunarodnih filmskih festivala: **Ana Souza** (Sundance Film Festival), **Wim Vanacker** (Cannes Film Festival), **Asja Krsmanović** (Sarajevo Film Festival), **Carla Vulpiani** (Venice Film Festival) i **Tim Redford** (Clermont-Ferrand International Short Film Festival).

Poseban dio festivala posvećen je mladim autorima i filmskom obrazovanju. **Silver Frame Film Residency** okupit će mlade autore iz regije koji će tokom festivala, uz podršku mentora, razvijati i realizovati kratke filmove povezane s ekologijom, klimatskim promjenama i lokalnim zajednicama.

Program rezidencije podržava **Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung.**

Pored filmskih projekcija, program uključuje masterklasove i radionice, među kojima su radionica animacije, stripa i storyboarda, program za djecu u Novoj Kasabi i radionica tradicionalne pripreme bureka.

U Domu kulture Srebrenica bit će otvorena i izložba „**Plakati bh. filmova 1951–2012.**“, realizovana u saradnji sa **Kinotekom Bosne i Hercegovine**.

Silver Frame Film Festival nastoji povezati međunarodnu filmsku scenu sa Srebrenicom i Bratuncem i stvoriti prostor u kojem se kroz film susreću različite generacije, iskustva i zajednice.

Festival se završava **17. jula** ceremonijom dodjele nagrada u Open Air Cinema prostoru EMMAUS-a.

Ulaz na sve festivalske projekcije je besplatan.

Silver Frame Film Festival Returns to Srebrenica and Bratunac for Its Second Edition, 14–17 July 2025

Srebrenica / Bratunac, July 2025 — The second edition of the **Silver Frame Film Festival** will take place from **14 to 17 July 2025** in **Srebrenica and Bratunac, Bosnia and Herzegovina**, bringing four days of film screenings, conversations, masterclasses, workshops, exhibitions and a film residency.

The Festival brings together films and filmmakers from different parts of the world while remaining deeply connected to the local community. The programme will take place across several venues, including the **Open Air Cinema and Cinema Room at EMMAUS**, the **Cultural Centre Srebrenica** and the **Cultural Centre Bratunac**.

Admission to the Festival programme is free.

This year's edition will present **seven feature-length films**, alongside **37 short films from around the world** across its competition programmes.

The Festival will officially open with the Academy Award-winning animated feature **Flow**, directed by **Gints Zilbalodis**.

The feature programme also includes **Gym** by Srđan Vuletić, presented in collaboration with the **Sarajevo Film Festival**; **Vermiglio** by Maura Delpero, in collaboration with the **Trieste Film Festival**; **Where Dragons Live** by Suzanne Raes, in partnership with Berlin's **Dokumentale**; **An American Pastoral** by Aubrey Edler, presented thanks to the collaboration with **Mediawan Rights**; and **Vittoria** by Alessandro Cassigoli and Casey Kauffman, in partnership with the **MedFilm Festival** in Rome.

The Festival will present several short-film competition programmes: **International Short Films**, **Green Short Films**, **Regional Student Short Films**, **International Student Short Films** and **Silver Frame Spotlight**.

The International Short Film programme continues to develop with the contribution of Honourable Selectors connected to some of the world's leading film festivals: **Ana Souza** (Sundance Film Festival), **Wim Vanacker** (Cannes Film Festival), **Asja Krsmanović** (Sarajevo Film Festival), **Carla Vulpiani** (Venice Film Festival) and **Tim Redford** (Clermont-Ferrand International Short Film Festival).

A significant part of Silver Frame is dedicated to emerging filmmakers and film education. The **Silver Frame Film Residency** will bring together young filmmakers from the region, who will develop and produce short films during the Festival with the guidance of experienced mentors, exploring ecology, climate change and local communities.

The Residency is supported by the **Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung**.

Alongside screenings, the programme includes masterclasses and workshops, including an animation, comics and storyboard workshop, a children's programme in Nova Kasaba and a traditional burek-making workshop.

The Cultural Centre Srebrenica will also host the exhibition "**Posters of Bosnian and Herzegovinian Films 1951–2012**", organised in collaboration with the **Film Archive of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Kinoteka BiH)**.

Silver Frame Film Festival seeks to connect the international film community with Srebrenica and Bratunac, creating a space where different generations, experiences and communities can meet through cinema.

The Festival will conclude on **17 July** with the Awards Ceremony at the EMMAUS Open Air Cinema.

Admission to all Festival screenings is free.
